City Superintendent Report

City Superintendent Julius Windholz gave his department report. Water consumption has decreased but the water level of the wells has not increased. Street project is progressing and JCorp will be starting on 13th Street. The new Christmas decorations are not completed yet so December 8 will be a better time for the Christmas light up.

Sewer Line Reimbursement

In the past when new construction taps into the current sewer line, the resident is charged for the cost of the sewer line. Jeff Crawford tapped into the city sewer line along Highway 40 and council felt he should reimburse the city \$1.75 per lot frontage instead of what it cost to originally have the sewer line installed. Additionally, this will be the rate charged for any future construction.

Police Department Report

Police Chief Cole Dinkel gave his department report. The patrol car is currently getting repaired. Dinkel would also like to have remote starts installed in the patrol car and pick-up. Consensus of the council was to have the remote starts installed.

Baseball Field

Councilmember Brungardt let council know that the school district is considering adding baseball thru a baseball association. They would have to make use of the city baseball field.

Water Rates

Water rates were discussed. Several councilmembers will work on getting rates from other cities and this matter will be tabled until the next meeting to get that information.

Health Facility Compensation

Mayor Unrein would like council to consider the compensation that is given to the Health Facility. This will also be tabled for the next meeting.

Master Academy

Consensus of the council was to have the City Clerk attend the Master Academy in Wichita on November 14 thru 16, 2012.

A Contractors license application was submitted by Alpine Construction/Dustin Donaldson. All items being in order, Motion to approve the contractors license application submitted by Alpine Construction by Leroy Schmidtberger, second by Jerry Brungardt.
