Regular Meeting

### **Minutes**

### **Warrant Ordinance A-03-13**

Ordinance A-03-13, consisting of bills against the City for the month of February was presented for review. Motion by Leroy Schmidtberger, second by Erica Dinges that Ordinance A-03-13 be approved and all bills paid.

## **Ellis County Sales Tax**

Ellis County Administrator Greg Sund and County Commissioner Dean Haselhorst gave a presentation on improvements to county buildings and the construction of an additional EMS and rural fire department building the County Commission would like to do with revenue collected from a half-cent sales tax that is being proposed to county residents at the next election. The county was asking the City of Victoria to return their portion of the sales tax back to the county to help pay for the improvements, if the sales tax increase is approved by the voters. Council is going to take time to review the information presented and make a decision at the next regular council meeting.

## **Ellis County Coalition Representative**

Ivan Werner, who is the current representative to the Ellis County Coalition for Economic Development spoke with council about the city still giving the pledge that is usually given yearly to the Coalition and the benefits of the organization.

## **Alan Luttrell**

Alan Luttrell from EBH was available to discuss water issues. He went over options the city can pursue to help with the water shortage the city is experiencing because of the drought.

## **City Superintendent Report**

City Superintendent Julius Windholz gave his department report. Crack sealing is completed for the year. Windholz also spoke about the parking lot at the health facility. It is going to have to be replaced in the near future. Council would like some type of estimate so it can be included in next years budget.

## **Police Department Report**

Police Chief Cole Dinkel gave his department report. Chief Dinkel was able to find a replacement patrol car and it was picked up earlier in the day. Dinkel was having some of the equipment from the old patrol car installed in the new one.

## **2013 Pledge**

After a short discussion, motion by Jerry Brungardt, second by Jan Piesker to give the 2013 Pledge of \$1,000 to the Ellis County Coalition for Economic Development.

## **Water Restrictions**

Council felt at this time the city needs to keep imposing the Stage 2 Water Restrictions with the only change moving evening watering from 7 to 10 pm instead of 9 pm to 12 midnight. The watering ordinance will first have to be rewritten, approved and published before the change goes into affect.

## **Lease Purchase Agreement Resolution**

Motion to approve the Lease Purchase Agreement Resolution with Gorham State Bank for the 2011 Alexis Fire Truck by Leroy Schmidtberger, second by Jerry Brungardt.

## **Annual Operation & Maintenance Agreement**

Motion to approve the 2013 Annual Operation and Maintenance Assurance Statement with the Kansas Department of Wildlife and Parks by Leroy Schmidtberger, second by Erica Dinges.

## **Data Compromise Coverage**

Motion by Leroy Schmidtberger, second by Jerry Brungardt to approve the additional insurance for Data Compromise Coverage under the cities insurance policy.
