First Call Health Facility

Brian Brady with First Call let council know they would like to proceed with getting federal funding approval. Their main concerns are the carpeting and walls. A rough estimate for industrial grade tile is \$7,500. City employees can repaint and patch holes in the walls.

First call would need 2,000 patient visits per year to make it work. Motion to replace the flooring and repair the walls pending federal approval for First Call by Leroy Schmidtberger, second by Jerry Brungardt.

Cora Schulte and Ilona Patterson discussed a visit with citizens from the Sister City in Germany. Schulte would like the city to be represented and give a gift from the city. City Superintendent Report

City Superintendent Jake Nuss gave his department report. Water tower has been repaired and had a water leak. The roof for the concession stand at the ball park will run around \$1,300.00 and tin has already been replaced on the dugouts. The city did receive an estimate for repairing some of the curbing. Motion by Jerry Brungardt, second by Leroy Schumacher to replace the curbing along the front of the Grade School on 10th Street and in front of Gambino's on 2nd Street.

Cole Dinkel gave his department report. Flooring in the police department is bad and would like to have it replaced at the same time the clinic floor is replaced. Went through town and got a list of unfit structures that need some attention.
