## ORDINANCE NO. B-280

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. B-272 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 8-102 of the Code of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

> 8-102. Meetings: Salary. The members of the Fire Department shall all be volunteers. They shall meet at least once each month for practice and drills. The chief shall keep a record of attendance at such meetings. Any member who shall fail to attend three consecutive meetings shall automatically become expelled from membership. Any member so expelled may be reinstated upon the vote of a majority of the members of the Fire Department subject to approval of the City Council at its next regularly scheduled meeting.

The chief shall receive the sum of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per meeting and twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) per fire call plus seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per hour after the first two hours of the fire call attended. The chief shall receive fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per fire call not attended, to complete the required forms. The secretary of the fire department shall receive ten dollars (\$10.00) per meeting and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per fire call plus seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per hour after the first two hours of the fire call attended. The other members of the department shall receive the sum of five dollars (\$5.00) per meeting and fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per fire call plus seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per hour after the first two hours of the fire call attended.

Section 2. Ordinance No. B-272 of the Code of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect on the 12th day of February, 1990, and after its publication in the Ellis County Star, the official city newspaper.
