Ordinance No. B-337

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, DESIGNATING A NO-PARKING AREA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to park a motorcycle, motor driven cycle, or motor vehicle as defined by Victoria Ordinance No. 106 on the south side of Seventh Street from Sunset Drive to Skyline Drive, and on the east side of Oak Street from Fourth Street to Fifth Street in the City of Victoria, Kansas.

Section 2. The penalty for violations of such traffic offense shall be a fine of not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00.

Section 3. Effective date. This Ordinance shall take effect and be enforced from and after its passage and publication once in the official city paper.
