ORDINANCE NO. B-354

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO AND PROVIDING A SPEED LIMIT IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS AND HIGHWAY 40 WITHIN THE CITY OF VICTORIA, ELLIS COUNTY, KANSAS, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF AND THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to drive at a speed in excess of 30 m.p.h. in any residence district; provided that the speed of any vehicle on Highway 40, between the intersection of the Highway with the east City limits and the intersection of the Highway with the west City limits shall not exceed 45 m.p.h.

Section 2. The fine for violation of such ordinance traffic infraction for which the municipal judge establishes a fine and a fine schedule shall not be less than \$10.00 nor more than \$500.00. A person tried and convicted for violation of an ordinance traffic infraction for which a fine has been established and a schedule of fines shall pay a fine fixed by the court not to exceed \$500.00.

Section 3. By passage of this ordinance, Ordinance No. 14-204(c)(2) is hereby repealed and amended as set forth herein.

Section 4. This ordinance shall be placed on file in the office of the City Clerk of Victoria, Kansas, and shall take effect and be in full force upon its publication once in the official City newspaper.
