ORDINANCE NO. B-387

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE PRESENT ALCOHOL BEVERAGES ORDINANCE BY ALLOWING THE CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ON ELECTION DAY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

Section 1. Chapter III, Article 2, Section 3-213 in subparagraph (c), of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Except as provided by Subsection (d), no cereal malt beverage may be sold or dispensed between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 6:00 a.m., or consumed between the hours of 12:30 a.m. and 6:00 a.m., or on Sunday, except in a place of business which is licensed to sell cereal malt beverage for consumption on the premises, which derives not less than thirty percent (30%) of its gross receipts from the sale of food for the consumption on the licensed premises.

<u>Section 2</u>. Chapter III, Article 3, Section 3-304, subsection (a) is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Ellis County Star, the official City newspaper.
