ORDINANCE NO. B-420

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE B-393 AS PASSED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS ON MARCH 10, 1997, AND AS PUBLISHED ON MARCH 20, 1997, BY AMENDING USER CHARGE RATES IN THE CITY OF VICTORIA, COUNTY OF ELLIS, STATE OF KANSAS, TO PROVIDE FUNDS NEEDED TO PAY FOR ALL EXPENSES ASSOCIATED WITH THE CITY'S WASTE WATER TREATMENT WORKS, AND AMENDING APPENDIX "A" TO USER CHARGE ORDINANCE (Actual Use Rate Structure).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

Section 1. Section 15-323 of the Code of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Actual Use Rate Structure. (Reference is made to Amended Appendix A of this Ordinance). The minimum charge per month shall be \$0.67. In addition, each contributor shall pay a user charge rate for operation and maintenance including replacement and debt retirement of \$1.54 per 1,000 gallons of water as determined in Ordinance No. B-393.

(Reference is made to Amended Appendix A of this Ordinance). For those contributors who contribute wastewater, the strength of which is greater than normal domestic sewage, a surcharge in addition to the normal user charge will be collected as determined in Section I of Ordinance B-393. The surcharge for operation and maintenance including replacement is:


\$ .288636	Per pound BOD
\$ .288636	Per pound SS

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect April 1, 1998, and after its publication one time in the Ellis County Star, the official City newspaper.
