
Be it ordained by the Governing Body of the City of Victoria;



Section One. In accordance with state law, the City of Victoria has conducted a public hearing and has published the proposed budget necessary to fund City services from January 1, 2000 until December 31, 2000.

Section Two. After careful public deliberations, it is hereby attested that in order to maintain the public services, which are essential for the citizens of this city, it will be necessary to utilize property tax revenues in an amount which exceeds the revenues expended in the budget year 1999.

Section Three. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication once in the official City newspaper, The Hays Daily Newspaper.
