ORDINANCE NO. 448

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENTS OF CITY EMPLOYEES WHO ARE APPOINTED OFFICIALS IN SUPERVISORY POSITIONS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

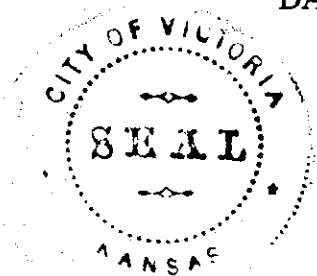
Section 1. The City of Victoria, Kansas, by the power vested in it by Article


12, Section 5 (c) of the Constitution of the State of Kansas, elected to exempt itself from and make inapplicable to it, K.S.A. 15-209, inclusive and any amendments thereto, which is an enactment of the legislature applicable to the City in Charter Ordinance 6 A passed by the Governing Body of the City of Victoria on March 13, 1989.

Section 2. The Governing Body shall require a provision that employees must be able to report to work in the case of inclement weather or respond to emergency situations in a reasonable amount of time.

Section 3. Upon employment with the City of Victoria, employee will establish a permanent residence within six (6) miles of Victoria City Limits. Residency must be established within six (6) months of hired date.
