ORDINANCE NO. B-461

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. B-456 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SETTING MEETING REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

Section 1. Section 8-102 of the Code of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:


8-102. Meetings: Salary. The members of the Fire Department shall be volunteers. They shall meet at least once each month for practice drills. The Chief shall keep a record of attendance at the meetings. Any member who shall fail to attend 75 percent of the scheduled Fire Department meetings per year shall be expelled from membership. Any member so expelled may be reinstated upon the vote of a majority of the members of the Fire Department subject to approval of the City Council.


The Chief shall receive the sum of one hundred twenty-five dollars (\$125.00) per month for administrative duties. The Assistant Chief shall receive seventy-five dollars (\$75.00) per month. The secretary of the Fire Department shall receive twenty-seven dollars and fifty cents (\$27.50) per meeting and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per fire call plus seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per hour after the first two hours of the fire call attended. The Chief and other members of the department shall receive the sum of twenty dollars (\$20.00) per meeting and twenty dollars (\$20.00) per fire call plus seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per hour after the first two hours of the fire call attended.

Section 2. Ordinance No. B-456 of the Code of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication in the Hays Daily News, the official City newspaper.
