ORDINANCE NO. B-506

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 15-221, OF CHAPTER XV, ARITCLE 2, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE B-493, AS PASSED ON MAY 21, 2007 AND AS PUBLISHED ON JUNE 1, 2007 BY PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE OF WATER RATES INSIDE THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, AND BY PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE OF WATER RATES OUTSIDE THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 15-221, of Chapter XV, Article 2, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Victoria, Kansas, as amended by Ordinance 493, as passed on May 21, 2007, and as published on June 1, 2007, is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>Sec. 15-221</u> Water Rates. All water sold by the City to regular customers shall be on a metered basis. The rates to be charged therefore shall be as follows:

INSIDE CITY

- A. A minimum charge of eleven dollars and fifty cents (\$11.50) for the first two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) each month.
- B. For all water in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) in any month two dollars and thirty cents (\$2.30) per one thousand gallons (1,000 gals.) in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.)

OUTSIDE CITY

- A. A minimum charge of twenty-three dollars (\$23.00) for the first two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) each month.
- B. For all water in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.) in any month four dollars and sixty cents (\$4.60) per one thousand gallons (1,000 gals.) in excess of two thousand gallons (2,000 gals.)

<u>Section 2.</u> Section 15-221, Chapter XV, Article 2, of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Victoria, Kansas, as adopted as amended by Ordinance No. B-493, as passed on May 21, 2007, and as published on June 1, 2007, is hereby repealed.
