ORDINANCE NO. B-512

AN ORDINANCE RESTRICTING HEAVY TRUCK TRAFFIC ON IRON STREET WITHIN THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

WHEREAS, heavy truck traffic within the City limits of Victoria, Kansas, especially on Iron Street, is incompatible with the normal and safe movement of traffic thereon; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Victoria, Kansas, finds it advisable to restrict such traffic.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

Section 1. Pursuant to K.S.A. 8-2002(14), the City of Victoria hereby restricts the use of heavy truck traffic on Iron Street from Fifth Street to Tenth Street by the use of trucks in excess of \(\begin{align*} \lorenth{O} \colon \rightarrow \text{pounds} \end{align*}.

<u>Section 2</u>. That Iron Street from Fifth Street to Tenth Street shall be appropriately signed to notify drivers of this restriction.

Section 3. That the fine for the violation of this Ordinance shall be a fine in the amount of $\frac{350}{600}$ for the first occurrence and $\frac{500}{600}$ for every occurrence thereafter.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper.
