ORDINANCE NO. B-540

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS; NAMELY, PROVIDING FOR REDUCED SPEED LIMIT THROUGH SCHOOL ZONES WITHIN THE CITY OF VICTORIA AND PROVIDING DOUBLING OF THE FINE IN VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

Section 1. The City of Victoria has incorporated the Standard Traffic Ordinance for the purpose of regulating traffic within the corporate limits of the City of Victoria, Kansas.

Section 2. Traffic Infractions.

(a) An ordinance traffic infraction is a violation of any section of this ordinance that prescribes or requires the same behavior as that prescribed or required by a statutory provision that is classified as a traffic infraction in K.S.A. 8-2118.

(b) All traffic violations which are included within this ordinance, and which are not ordinance traffic infractions, as defined in subsection (a) of this section, shall be considered traffic offenses.

Section 3. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Standard Traffic Ordinance, there is a need to reduce the speed limit in the school zone within the City of Victoria, Kansas, on 10th Street from Cathedral Avenue to Jefferson Avenue and to reduce such speed to 20 m.p.h. during school hours, namely, 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday during the regular school year.

Section 4. Penalty for Speeding in School Zone. The fine for speeding in excess of 20 m.p.h. in said school zone during the school year shall be double for which a fine has been established by the schedule of the municipal court judge.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect after its publication in The Russell County News, the official City newspaper.
