**RESOLUTION - WATER DROUGHT**

WHEREAS, the Governing Body of the City of Victoria, Kansas, passed a Water Drought/Emergency Ordinance, Ordinance B-470, on May 17, 2004, incorporating a Municipal Water Conservation Plan for the City of Victoria;

RESOLVED, Council for the City of Victoria met on the 17 day of February, 2014, for the purpose of determining whether an emergency exists by reason of a shortage of water supply needed for essential uses of the City; and


WHEREAS, Council for the City of Victoria, Kansas, has determined that an emergency does exist by reason of a shortage of water supply needed for essential uses and that it will impose mandatory restrictions on water use during the period of the emergency. The Governing Body has deemed that the emergency shall continue until it is declared by resolution of the Governing Body to have ended.

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the existence of a water supply emergency exists and such emergency shall be effective upon the publication of this Resolution in the official City


newspaper and shall continue until such time as it is declared by resolution of the Governing Body to have ended.
