Police Department Report

City Superintendent Report

City Superintendent Brad Schmidtberger gave his department report. A contract for the purchasing of water from Trego has been sent to the lawyer. Schmidtberger and Terry Riedel will be attending some training. Schmidtberger would also like to check into getting a bagger attachment for one of the mowers to use around the swimming pool.

USD 432 Water Billing

USD 432 Superintendent David Ottley asked for consideration of some type of reduction on the water bills. With the new rates the school will be paying a considerably higher water bill. Council will have a work session to go over different scenarios of reducing the school districts water bills.

Outdoor Weather Sirens

Ellis County Emergency Manager Darin Meyers spoke to council about the possibility of updating the current outdoor weather sirens. Meyers would like to see a county wide system implemented. Council would like to have a study conducted to see how many sirens would actually be needed and where the best placement would be, along with estimates for new sirens.

Pool Managers

Pool Managers Karen Nowak and Haley Robben approached council about the possibility of improving and updating the pool. Council would like the managers to get together a plan of what they would like to see done and bring it to another meeting.

Health Facility Air Conditioner

The air conditioning unit at the health facility needed to be replaced and the work was done by Shubert Heating and Air. Motion to approve the repair of the A/C unit at the Health Facility for \$3,650.00 by Jerry Brungardt, second by Leroy Schmidtberger.
