## **Police Report**

Patrol Officer Ryan Mauch gave the police department report. The new patrol vehicle has been completely accessorized. They will also be attending some training in March.

## **City Superintendent Report**

City Superintendent Brad Schmidtberger gave his department update. The water tower is up and a paint color needs to be chosen. Consensus of the Council was to paint the tower white with maroon and yellow lettering.

## **Unfit Structure**

Ron Quint agreed to have his residence torn down by January 1, 2021. Nothing has been done yet. Council will get an additional estimate and have a special meeting to proceed with demolition.

## **LMI Survey**

Council felt that at this time it would not pay to send out an LMI survey since the last time the City did not qualify. Council has not felt much has changed since the last survey.

## **Water Project Pay Estimates**

Pay estimates were submitted for the water project for Council approval by EBH Engineering, Rural Water District No. 2 and Gerard Tank & Steel. Motion to approve the pay estimates submitted by EBH Engineering for \$21,308.73, Rural Water District No. 2 for \$107,576.90, and Gerard Tank & Steel for \$122,882.50, by Erica Dinges, second by Dustin Schumacher.
