EMERGENCY SNOW ROUTES

The City of Victoria will be implementing Snow Routes.

The following streets have been established as emergency snow routes within the city:

- Cathedral Street
- 10th Street
- Main Street
- East and West Main Street
- 3rd Street

In a snow emergency there will be no parking on the streets listed above. The city will announce when a snow emergency exists on our Facebook page and local media.

PENALTY. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be punished as Class C by fine of not more than \$500.

COMPOST SITE REMINDER

Please be aware that cameras are in use at the compost site. Unfortunately, we've seen an increase in improper dumping, including trash, pop cans, cat food cans, and cat litter being left in grass piles. This site is for compostable materials only- no garbage of any kind should be dumped. Anyone caught violating these rules on camera may be subject to a fine. Help us keep the compost site clean and usable for everyone by following the guidelines.

SCOOTERS & BIKES

There have been a number of complaints to the City of Victoria and the Victoria Police Department regarding kids riding around town. Parents, please talk with your children about proper scooter/bike use and make sure they understand local traffic laws and safety guidelines. Your child needs to stay to the side of the road when possible and obey all traffic signals. Let's work together to keep our streets safe for everyone.

WATERING GUIDELINES

- No filling of water storage containers
- Waste of water will be prohibited
- No running hose may be left unattended
- No water will be allowed to escape the property, (example: no water running down the curb, sidewalk, etc)

Lawn watering:

No lawn watering may take place between the hours of 10:00 am and 7:00 pm

Residents South of 10th Street: Allowed to water their lawn on Wednesday and Saturday

Residents North of 10th Street: Allowed to water their lawn on Thursday and Sunday

Flowers, trees, shrubs and gardens:

May be watered any day, but not between the hours of 10:00 am and 7:00 pm

The recreation commission will be installing Tee-Boxes in the near future. We want to remind players to be mindful of where they're throwing, particularly at Hole #7.
