ORDINANCE NO. B-277

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SEC. 9-308 OF CHAPTER IV, ARTICLE III, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE B-268, AS PASSED ON JUNE 12, 1989 AND AS PUBLISHED ON JUNE 15, 1989 BY PROVIDING FOR AN INCREASE OF GARBAGE AND/OR RUBBISH COLLECTION RATES IN THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS:

Section 1. Sec. 9-308 of Chapter IV, Article III, of the code of Ordinances of the City of Victoria, Kansas, as amended by Ordinance B-268, as passed on June 12, 1989, and as published on June 15, 1989, is hereby amended to read as follows:

9-308. RATES AND COLLECTION CHARGES; REDUCED RATES FOR RESIDENTS 65 YEARS OF AGE AND OVER.

(a) Each residence receiving garbage and/or rubbish collection services within the city limits shall be charged five dollars (\$5.00) per month for said service, and each business or establishment other than residential receiving garbage and/or rubbish collection service shall be charged a minimum of five dollars (\$5.00) per month and a maximum of Fifty five dollars (\$55.00) per month, the exact charge to be based on collection time and volume of garbage and/or rubbish to be removed by the collector. A request for water service shall automatically constitute a request for refuse service. A termination of water service shall automatically terminate refuse service. The charges for collection of garbage and/or rubbish and charges for water and sewer service in the city are hereby declared to be parts of one (1) debt to the city insofar as the same affect any one (1) customer, and the refusal or failure to pay any part of such debt for any monthly period of service in accordance with the rules and regulations established by the governing body of the city shall be sufficient cause for discontinuing water and sewer services. The garbage and rubbish collection fee shall be charged to the water bill of any person receiving the garbage and/or rubbish collection service.

(b) Upon application by residents who are 65 years of age or over being made to the City Clerk of Victoria, Kansas, prior to the 20th day of any given month, such applicants upon proof of their age shall be charged a reduced rate of three dollars and fifty cents (\$3.50) per month for garbage and/or rubbish collection within the city, provided, however, that such a reduced rate shall be available only for the residence of the eligible applicants and not for business properties. Persons already receiving the reduced rate do not need to re-apply.

line of Allen Street opposite the northwest corner of Block 7, Original Town of Herzog; thence south along the west line of Allen Street a distance of 695 feet; thence east 725 feet; thence south 100 feet west of and parallel to the west line of Cathedral Avenue a distance of 940 feet; thence east 100 feet to the west line of Cathedral Avenue; thence south 442 feet; thence east 892 feet; thence south 270 feet to a point which is 237 feet southwest of the intersection of the west line of Oak Street, and the north line of Fifth Street, and 283 feet north of the north line of Fourth Street; thence southwesterly 107 feet to a point which is 265 feet north of the North line of Fourth Street; thence south 265 feet to the North line of Fourth Street; thence west along the North line of Fourth Street 720 feet more or less to the west line of Cathedral Avenue; thence south 240 feet; thence east 900 feet more or less to the North line of the Union Pacific Railroad Right-of-way; thence southwesterly along the north line of the said right-of-way 410 feet; thence southeasterly 400 feet to the south right-of-way of Union Pacific Railroad; thence northeasterly along said right-of-way 445 feet more or less to a point which is 200 feet west of the West line of West Main Street; thence south along a line 200 feet west of and parallel to the west line of West Main Street 200 feet; thence east 100 feet; thence south 358.4 feet to the North side of U.S. Highway 40 Right-of-way; thence south a distance of 106.6 feet to the south side of U.S. Highway 40 Right-of-way; thence south 140 feet; thence east 112 feet to the West line of West Main Street; thence south 435 feet; thence east 80 feet; thence south 762 feet; thence east 450 feet; thence north 484 feet; thence west 330 feet; thence north 278 feet to the point of beginning.

This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the official city newspaper of the City of Victoria, Kansas.
