ORDINANCE NO. B-588

AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. B-567 OF THE CODE OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SETTING MEETING REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT, AND INCREASING THE SALARY OF THE MEMBERS OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

BE IT ORDERED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF VICTORIA, KANSAS.

Section 1. Section 7-102 of the Code of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

7-102. Meetings: Salary. The members of the Fire Department shall be volunteers. They shall meet at least once each month for practice drills. The Chief shall keep a record of attendance at the meetings. Any member who fails to attend 75 percent of the scheduled Fire Department meetings per year shall be expelled from membership. Any member so expelled may be reinstated upon the vote of a majority of the members of the Fire Department subject to approval of the City Council.

1. The Fire Chief shall receive the sum of \$400 per month for administrative duties.
2. The Assistant Chief shall receive \$200 per month for his duties.
3. The Secretary of the Fire Department shall receive \$150 per month.
4. The Captains of the Fire Department will receive \$30.00 per call; \$30 per hour after the first hour of the fire call attended; \$30 for monthly meetings; and \$30 per monthly trainings.
5. All members of the Department shall receive the sum of \$25 per meeting; \$25 per call plus \$25 per hour after the first hour of the fire call. All members of the Department shall receive \$25 per day for monthly training. Any extra training will be paid at the rate of \$10 per hour not to exceed \$80 per day.
6. All members of the Department shall be paid for the use of their personal vehicle at the IRS mileage rate which is allowed by the IRS for business purposes.

Section 2. Ordinance No. B-567 of the Code of the City of Victoria, Kansas, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect after its publication in the Russell County News, the official City newspaper.
